

Rownhams Lane Dental Care Plan

At Rownhams Lane our aim is to provide high quality care and treatment in a relaxed, comfortable and safe environment. We are committed to continuing education and keeping abreast of the changes in modern dentistry.

Research shows that preventive dentistry delivered on a regular basis greatly reduces the risk of dental disease and provides a platform for a lifetime of improved oral health. We encourage such an approach and with this in mind, we have joined with DPAS Limited to design a dental plan to reward loyal patients. This plan will be administered by DPAS who will make a separate arrangement with you to manage your payments under the plan. The plan will provide advantages both to you and to us. It will allow us to plan your dental care more effectively and provide the best chance of keeping you dentally fit. The advantage for you is that it should reduce the need for future treatment and you will have the peace of mind that all of your preventive dental care will be covered by convenient monthly payments. Upon joining the dental plan, you will also be eligible to request assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme for dental emergencies or dental traumas whilst at home or abroad (see overleaf).

Key benefits include:

- Regular examinations and Hygienist visits give you the best preventative care for long term dental health
- Regular monthly payments help you to spread the cost of your preventative care over the year
- 20% discount on treatment fees (adults only for Plans 1, 2, and 3, subject to consultation)
- 50% discount on treatment fee when treatment is required for the Young Person Prevention Plan (subject to consultation)
- Access to a 24 hour dental emergency helpline 365 days per year
- Eligibility to request assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme (see overleaf).



A Point to Ponder:

Money spent on prevention keeps you problem and pain free for long periods of time. If treatment is necessary at some stage, it is likely to be minor rather than major.

Prevention Plan 1: *£16.53 per month*

- 2 detailed examinations per year
- 1 Dental Hygienist visit per year
- All clinically necessary x-rays
- 20% discount on treatment fees
- Eligibility to request assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme (see overleaf).

- 2 detailed examinations per year
- 2 Dental Hygienist visits per year
- All clinically necessary x-rays
- 20% discount on treatment fees
- Eligibility to request assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme (see overleaf).

Prevention Plan 3: *£8.61 per month*

- 1 detailed examination per year
- All clinically necessary x-rays
- 20% discount on treatment fees
- Eligibility to request assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme (see overleaf).

Young Person Prevention Plan:

0 - under 7 **£3.00 per month**

7 - under 18 **£5.00 per month**

18 - under 23 **£7.00 per month**

- 2 detailed examinations per year
- All clinically necessary x-rays
- 50% discount on treatment fees (subject to consultation)
- Eligibility to request assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme (see overleaf).

The monthly plan cost includes the charges for management and administration payable by you to DPAS.

Emergency appointment fee from £35.00.



Who are our plans for?

Our plans are designed for patients who wish to attend the practice on a regular basis and have peace of mind that their preventive dental care is covered. Please note, treatment is not covered in our plans and should be paid for separately (with the discount applied). Estimates will be given for all treatment provided.

How do I join the plan?

Adults and Children can join the plan after an Initial Independent Examination with Miss Dave:

Adult Fee: £85.20 inclusive of all small x-rays

Child Fee (under 18): £42.60 inclusive of all small x-rays

Registration/Mandate forms are available from the practice. Completed forms are to be sent to DPAS in the SAE provided.

They will contact your bank/building society to set up your direct debit mandate for the monthly "plan payments".

In addition to your first monthly payment, a registration fee of £10.00 per patient will be charged by DPAS.

A routine PAYG fee for adults is £57.80

A routine PAYG fee for a child is £28.90

How to cancel plan membership?

If you choose to leave the plan for any reason you can do so by simply giving us one month's notice and you must contact the practice to ensure sufficient payments have been made to cover any plan appointments taken during the "plan year".

What happens in an emergency?

If you are at home and within easy reach of the practice, phone Reception to book an emergency appointment. If you are away from home in the UK or abroad you will have access to a 24 hour, 365 day worldwide dental emergency helpline, which will endeavour to find an English speaking dentist to assist you.

HOW DOES THE WORLDWIDE DENTAL EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE SCHEME WORK?

Whilst a member of the dental plan, should you suffer a dental trauma, a dental emergency or be diagnosed with oral cancer you will be eligible to make a request for assistance from the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme. The Scheme responds to such requests on a wholly discretionary basis. This means that, whilst the Scheme aims to provide benefits in most cases, the Scheme has no obligation to provide any benefit unless the Scheme Manager (the person appointed to administer the Scheme) first decides (in its sole and absolute discretion) that the Scheme should provide a benefit. There are some circumstances in which the Scheme is not designed to help (these situations being similar to exclusions under an insurance policy) and these are explained in more detail in the Worldwide Dental Emergency Assistance Scheme Handbook. The Scheme Manager will look at each case individually to assess the request for a benefit. Certain restrictions and limitations may apply in the event that your request for assistance is accepted and it is possible that in some cases the Scheme Manager will decide to provide no benefit.

If your request for assistance is accepted by the Scheme Manager you will be eligible to receive benefit payments from the Scheme in the following situations (up to the limits set by the Scheme and published from time to time):

- ✓ The cost of dental treatment by any dentist up to a maximum of £10,000 for any one incident of dental trauma
- ✓ The cost of:
 - emergency call-outs
 - pain relief or emergency temporary treatment
- ✓ A specified amount for each complete 24-hour period of hospitalisation wholly or partly under the care of a consultant who specialises in dental or maxillofacial surgery
- ✓ A specified amount if you are diagnosed with oral cancer and this is the primary cancer site

You will also have 24 hour access to a worldwide dental emergency helpline.
